Responsibilities of the Good Neighbor Race Director:

- Uphold SAR's mission and vision statements
- The race date and location have been selected to minimize conflicts with other SAR races/events
- All required permits (City, County, TPD, Barricades, etc) have been obtained to ensure safety of all participants
- Adequate liability coverage has been obtained
- Online registration website denotes race as SAR good neighbor event
- A discount will be given to all early registration SAR members (~10-15% off)
- SAR logo will be placed on registration flyers
- SAR has the option to set up a booth at the end of the race for promotion purposes
- Donate to a charitable organization, as chosen by the race director, to promote running/fitness programs
- Write a post race article highlighting event for SAR website (top finishers, amount raised for charity, sponsors, etc)

Responsibilities of SAR:

- Have good neighbor race advertising badge on SAR home page for 1 month prior to the event at no cost
- The good neighbor race is highlighted in the SAR newsletter as such under upcoming events
- Post race article on SAR website, written by the good neighbor race director, highlighting the race (top finishers, amount raised for charity, sponsors, etc)
- Race results posted on SAR website within a reasonable time frame
