

Welcome to the 2018 Sabino Canyon Sunset Run, brought to you by the Southern Arizona Roadrunners. Thanks for being a part of this unique event! Here are few reminders for race day:

Race Day Schedule

10:15am-12:30pm	Packet pickup at Performance Footwear on Broadway
4:00pm-5:15pm	Packet pickup at Sabino Canyon
5:15 PM	7.4 mile early start time for walkers and non-competitive runners, and runners aged 60 and above*
5:45 PM	7.4 mile competitive race start
6:15 PM	Free Kid's Fun Run (a few hundred yards)
7:45 PM	Awards Ceremony

***Runners 60 and above are eligible for age group prizes and Grand Prix Points, regardless of start time. We are encouraging all runners 60 and above to choose the 5:15PM early start in order that they may run competitively against each other.**

***Everyone below 60 years old who does the early start is not eligible for overall or age group awards.**

Packet pickup

On race day, you can pick up your race number and t-shirt at Performance Footwear, 5350 E Broadway Blvd # 170, between **10:15 AM and 12:30 PM**. When you stop in be sure to check out their extensive inventory of everything for running. Alternatively, packet pickup is available at the park from 4:00PM to 5:15PM.

Parking / fees / car pooling / overflow parking

Parking in the Sabino Canyon main lot is somewhat limited, **please carpool if possible**. The park charges a \$5 fee for parking in the main lot unless you already have an annual pass (also available for purchase at the park). The parking lot will fill up prior to the start of the race.

Park for free at one of the two overflow lots: either of the two schools just north of the Canyon parking lot, Canyon View Elementary School (5725 N. Sabino Canyon Road) and Esperero Middle School (5801 N. Sabino Canyon Road). Parking is not allowed on Sabino Canyon Road north of Sunrise Drive, the police will ticket illegally parked cars.

Kid's Race

There will be a short, free kid's race taking place soon after the start of the main race.. Please be aware we will not be able to provide child care.

Course / Safety

Sunset is at 6:55 PM. **Aid stations (mile 1.7, mile 3.7 and mile 5.7)** and finish line will be picked up 105 minutes after the start. If you plan to be out on the course after dark please be aware you'll be on your own. Carry a flashlight, blinky light, headlamp, etc! There may be members of the Sabino Canyon Bike Patrol and/or Park Personnel on the course to increase park safety.

This is an out-and-back course on a winding road. For the safety of all participants, **stay to the right** to avoid runners coming in the opposite direction.

If you are participating in the 7.4 mile non-competitive event, please be yield to the competitive entrants. Stay to the right, avoid walking in wide groups that block the road, and cross the bridges single-file once the first runners start over-taking you. In addition to water stops on the course, there are several park water fountains and bathrooms available to use.

Awards

The awards ceremony will be held in the park, near the finish area. See the website for more information on award categories. Many thanks to our great prize sponsors, Performance Footwear (www.performancefootwear.net) and Summit Hut (www.summithut.com) for providing some great prizes. In addition to awards, we will be raffling off several prizes. You must be present to win.
